Great Valley Center's Energy Careers Experience Program (ECEP)

This is an exceptional opportunity for responsible students. If selected, you will have the chance to:

- **Build relationships with small business and agricultural customers and within the PG&E organization;**
- **Promote energy efficiency within your community while maintaining the flexible schedule you need to continue classes;**
- **Gain hands-on experience in the energy industry conducting energy assessments and more.**

What will I be doing?

The Great Valley Center (GVC) will match talented interns with PG&E Energy Solutions & Service (ES&S) departments to augment the work of their representatives. PG&E representatives will act as mentors and provide training. Following training, you will work within your service area to coordinate energy audits and provide customers with information regarding energy efficiency practices and solutions. GVC staff will provide assistance throughout the internship. You will learn energy efficiency practices, foster the ability to recognize opportunities specific to each customer's needs, expand your professional network, and develop a greater understanding of the roles different entities play in the economy – all while becoming energy efficiency experts!

What will the opportunity pay?

Interns will receive \$10.00/hour and mileage incurred will be reimbursed at \$0.575/mile.

What are the requirements?

In addition to a positive attitude and proven ability to stick with projects to completion, the following are needed:

- Strong interpersonal skills (e.g. ability to respond to challenging questions posed by utility customers);
- Current student or recent graduate;
- Availability to work 16-30 hrs per week throughout the entire project timeline (April – August 2015);
- Valid driver's license, current vehicle insurance and registration, and reliable transportation to/from assigned PG&E office and customer sites;
- Adherence to all safety requirements;
- Responsible, driven, self-sufficient;
- Professional demeanor;
- Problem solver.

Is this a competitive internship? How can I stand out when I apply?

Yes, we expect many students will have an interest. We expect to have up to 16 placements available between the Stockton, Modesto, Merced, Madera, Fresno, and Bakersfield PG&E offices. One way to stand out is to highlight your related experience when applying. The following are especially desirable:

- Knowledge of small business operations, farming operations, and issues affecting the business or agricultural industries;
- Familiarity with energy efficiency and the electricity and natural gas industry;
- Strong interpersonal and customer service skills.
